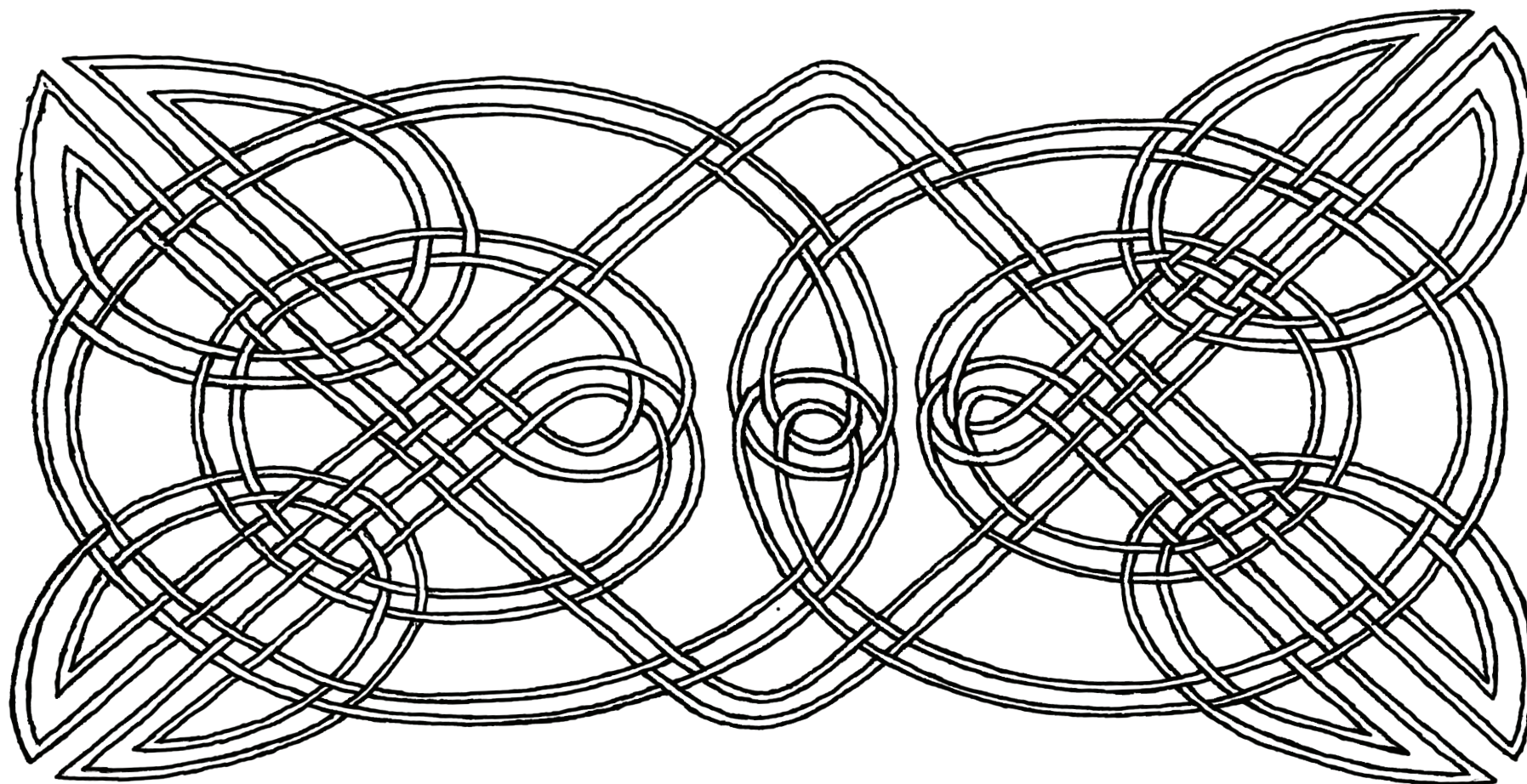
Preface

What are numbers and where do they come from? In the history books we can not find a lot about the origin of numbers. As I can imagine that our decimal calculation system is based on our ten fingers I still wonder what appeared first, the letters or the numbers? Or did they appear together? To answer these questions of where the names of the numbers in English come from, one need not to look at the languages with 204 speakers, or compare all 6912 languages to find the answer, or rummage in now lost languages from across the globe and its history. When we look at the numbers it is clear they are signs. Personally I am charmed of the idea we have had before we had anything like our so known numbers and letters as we know them as they are today, symbols from where the numbers and letters are originated and we do use nowadays symbols we have borrow from the Arabs. Man must have had understanding, however vague, of number, size and form. Paleontologists have found more than 70.000 year old ochre stones in a cave in South Africa, with geometric figures. Also finds of artefacts all over the globe like in Europe, America, Asia and Australia show that prehistoric man was well aware of indicating numbers, counting, drawing and recognizing these. Over the millennia the creative capacity of prehistoric man increased. A large number of artistic cave paintings have been preserved. Those paintings of animals and hunters, found mainly in Spain and France and about 15,000 years old, presumably had a ritual meaning and show that there was an excellent understanding of a two-dimensional representation of space forms. A symbol is a sign in which there is no natural relationship between the representation of the sign and the meaning that is expressed with it. Like for instance the symbols on a tombstone, symbols on a playing card etc. Symbols are a signifier; it has on the one hand a form or representation, and on the other hand a meaning. The meaning of a symbol is conventional. It is usually based on agreements that the users of the symbol (as in the language) have made. The users of the system of which the symbol is part of.

Semiotics distinguishes two other types of signs besides the symbol: the index and the icon.

History of numbers

For the notation of the numbers the Egyptians invented the first ciphered numeral system. They were actually developed by Arabic Muslim scientists who revised the Indian version of numbers that contains only nine numbers. That took place during the 8th century (771 A.D) when an Indian Gas-tronomist came to the Almansour royal palace with a book about astronomy and mathematics called “Sod hanta” written by Brahma Jobta around 626 A.D. Almansour ordered to translate the book into Arabic and explore more sciences. This we call the Hindu Arabic numerals. The number system notation development is credited to two great mathematicians from ancient India, Aryabhat (5th century BC) and Brahmagupta (6 thcentury BC). As it were different forms in the Indian version of numbers the Arabs kept some of these forms and changed others to create their own vision of numbers which was used in the Middle East and mainly in Baghdad. Thanks to Mohammed ibn Moesa al - Chwarizmi (Algoritmi), Arabic numbers took their final form. At the beginning, they were not widely spread but they became known in the Maghreb and Andalusia. Europe then adopted these numbers because of their practicality in comparison with Roman numbers. Now they are used worldwide.

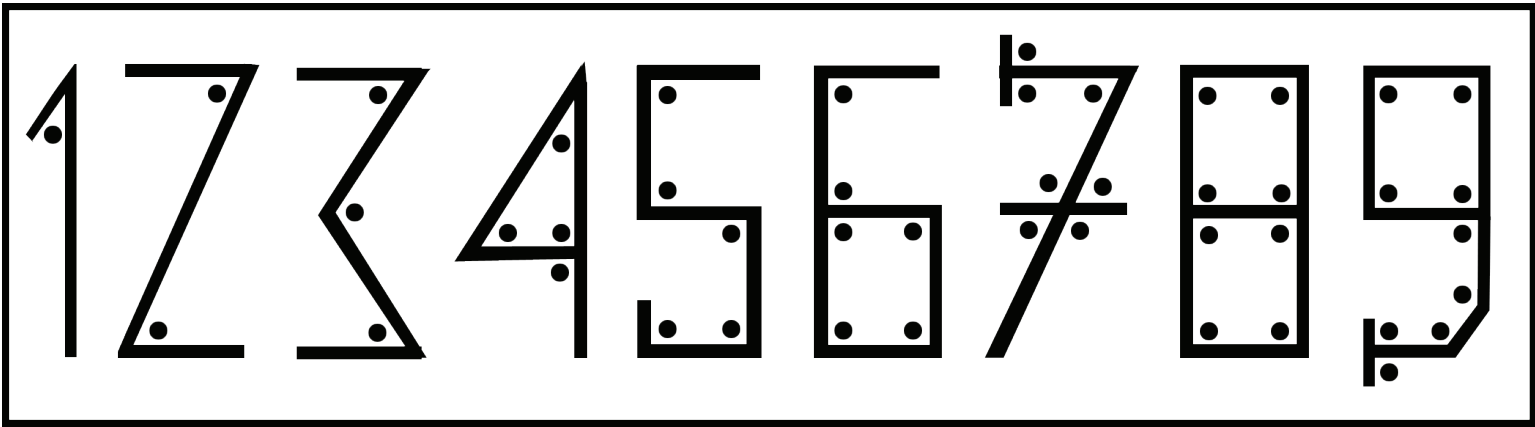
A number is a single symbol that indicates a countable number. The western digits of the decimal system are: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 and 0. They are called Arabic numerals, but in fact they are from India. In Swahili, the numbers one through five are of Bantu origin while six through ten are pure Arabic. The scientists in the Muslim world, who wrote their works in Arabic, have taken them from there. One of them was the Persian scientist Mohammed ibn Moesa al - Chwarizmi.

The abbreviation “no.” for the word “number” comes from the numero symbol (also written as “No.” or “no.”), which is in turn derived from the Latin word numero. This is one number that does in fact derive its name from Arabic the number 0. When the Arabic people encountered this number in adopting the numerical system, they had no name for it, so they translated the Sanskrit name, sunyam, nothing, empty place, which is in Arabic sifr. This word was borrowed into medieval Latin in different forms, zephirum and cifr, ciferea, ciphra.

The zero is referred to in Middle English, as sometimes are the whole of the Arabic numeral system, as “cifr”, a cipher, nothing, naught. The word comes into Middle English from French and medieval Latin. Medieval Latin spelling gave Italian “zefir” for zero as well and eventually the “f” was dropped to become “zero”, passed to French as “zero” and into English about 1600 as “zero” where over the centuries it eventually beat out cipher as the name of the symbol 0.

These digits were introduced in Europe within the XII century by Leonardo Pisano (aka Fibonacci), an Italian mathematician. L. Pisano was educated in North Africa, where he learned and later carried to Italy the now popular Hindu-Arabic numerals. Hindu numeral system is a pure place-value sys-tem, that is why you need a zero. Only the Hindus, within the context of Indo-European civilisations, have consistently used the 0. The Arabs, however, played an essential part in the dissemination of this numeral system. The Greeks followed by mapping their counting numbers onto Ionian and Doric alphabets. The system that used combinations of letters from the Roman alphabet are Roman numerals and where dominant in Europe until the superior Arabic numeral system around the late 14th century started to be in use. As the Arabic numeral system is still the most common system for represent-ing numbers in the world today. The key to the effectiveness of the system was the symbol for zero, developed by ancient mathematicians in the Indian subcontinent around 500 AD.

Numbers are based on a particular form on the number of angles that each number should contain (see picture). For instance, the number one contains only one angle, number two has two angles, and number three includes three angles, etc. This picture clarifies the original forms of the Arab numbers, in each angle contains a dot:



Numbers are mathematical objects used to count, measure and to label also. The original examples are the natural numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and the 0. The notational symbol that represents a number is called a numeral. In addition to their use in counting and measuring. Figures are originally intended to display numbers, cardinal numbers and rank numbers or ordinal numbers, but are also used in numbers or other series of numbers. The way we use numbers do refer to a symbol, a word, or a mathematical abstraction. Sometimes the numbers are supplemented with letters and other signs.

To indicate a position within a ranking, for example with a house number. This is also called a “sequence number”, for example on a waiting list. The numbers are not always consecutive. Uniqueness is not automatically enforced for sequence values. The ability to reuse sequence values is by design. If sequence values in a table are required to be unique, create a unique index. For identification as example with a bank account number, without there being a hierarchy, but they are also used in numbers or other series of numbers, for example telephone numbers, pin and slot codes and (parts of) postal codes.

Numbers can tell us often a lot, only if we want to least listen at it or they can give us an impuls or message. What these impulses or messages are depend on that what is being looked at. What the exact context is. In this book I show some practical examples in which I use the method of Gijsbert van der Zeeuw.

This method mainly uses the birth dates. There are two differences. Namely the method without the century number and the method with the century number. The outcome of the birth date without century number gives your soul number and this says more about who you are when you come to the world. The method with the number of the century added gives the life purpose number. This indicates not only what you are on this planet, but more important, why? It is important to see numerology as a tool only and you should not pin yourself down on any outcome. Van der Zeeuw says that you can get something out of the numbers, but you have to use it as an inductor.

It works best on your feelings, our sixth sense, which is in most cases your best advisor. Your talent as a visionary and your original and unconventional character are needed in this. Don't be afraid of modernity, because we are very capable of reconciling modernism with a certain amount of social conformity. We need to be doubly lucid and intelligent to counter these tendencies which are as strange as they are useless. That goes without saying while calculating, for example a date of birth, with using the latent gift that everyone possesses that is 'awake' and it has to be said this can say more than the date indicates. or what this book tells.

Aztecs and their numbering

In terms of expressing numbers, the Aztecs used a vigesimal (base 20) number system. A single dot (•) represented the number 1. Occasionally, a finger was also used to indicate the number. Following in this sequence, the numbers 2, 3, and 4 were represented by two, three, and four dots, respectively. 5, though, introduced a new symbol; it was represented by five dots (•••••) or a full bar, as seen in the accompanying figure. From 6 through 9, dots alone or a combination of dots and a bar represented numbers. 10 was represented by a rhombus, two bars, or ten dots. The numbers between 10 and 20 were expressed as a combination of a rhombus, bars, and dots. 20 required a new symbol and resembled a flag, a shell, or a vase with grass growing out of it. After 20, higher numbers were expressed as combinations of the symbols already mentioned. The numbers for 100, 200, and 300 were expressed not only with the mentioned symbols but also by a feather with barbs, each representing twenty units. 100 had five barbs on the feather, 200 had ten, and 300 had fifteen. The next change in symbol occurred at the number 400, which was sometimes represented by twenty barbs on the feather by a bundle of stems tied together. The number 8000 was written as a symbol that represented a bag. The idea that the Aztec system was vigesimal stems from the fact that new symbols were produced for every power of 20; this reasoning, though, is not completely satisfactory because the symbols for higher powers (204, 205, etc.) are unknown.

In terms of writing these numbers, the Aztec system mirrored that of the Egyptians. The positioning of symbols had no bearing; they could be written in any order, but were grouped together and written adjacent to each other. The Aztec number system was additive—the symbols were added together to produce the desired number. The number 0 was not prevalent in this number system. The Aztecs had a conceptual idea of what zero was, but there is no proof that they had a symbol representing it. A symbol for the number 0 played an interesting role in the Aztec culture. As stated earlier, when the Aztecs took over another civilization, they took pieces of its culture as well. In the Olmec civilization, which preceded the Aztecs, the shell represented 0. In the Aztec civilization, the shell represents the number 20. It seems that when the Aztecs took over the Olmec culture, they took the shell to represent the number 20 rather than 0. Following from that example, it would make sense to assume that other symbols were taken from conquered civilizations; however, there is not enough evidence to support it.

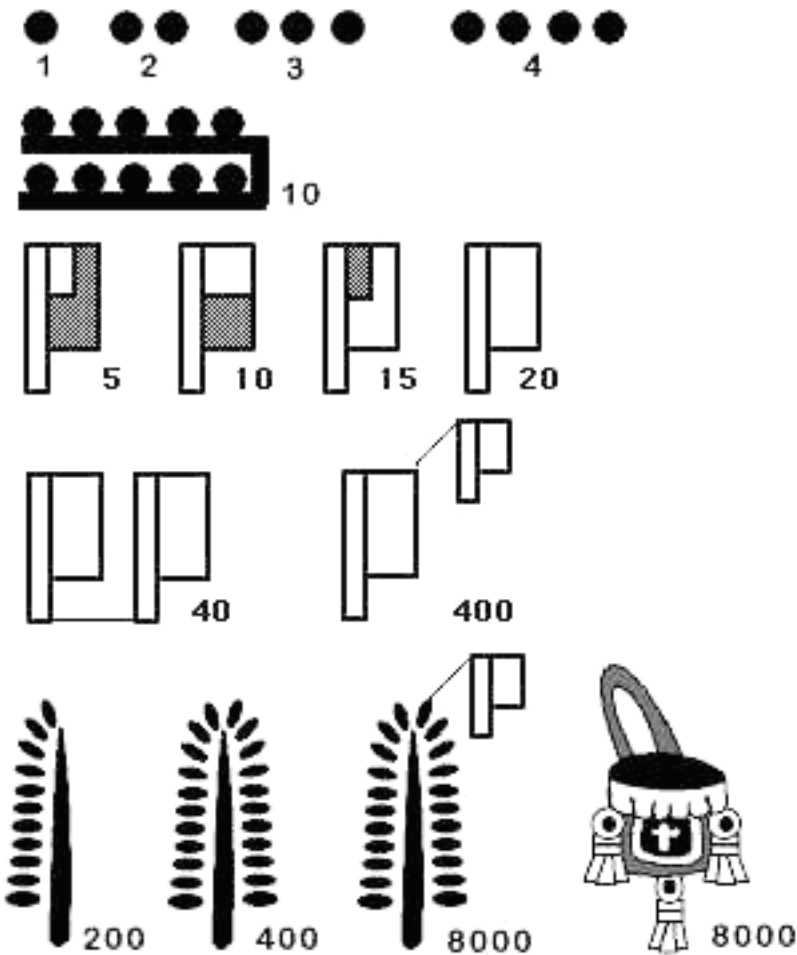


Lords of the Night

The Nine Lords of the Night were in Mesoamerican calendars a set of nine gods who ruled over a specific night. The nine gods worked in an endless circle, so that after every nine days the same god came back again. One could say that they knew a ‘week’ of nine days. In the Aztec calendar, the following gods formed the “Nine Lords of the Night”:

- Xiuhtecuhtli
- Itztli
- Piltzintecuhtli
- Cinteotl
- Mictlantecuhtli
- Chalchiuhtlicue
- Tlazolteotl
- Tepeyollotl
- Tlaloc

The Mayan calendar also has a 9-day cycle that is supposed to correspond to that of the “Nine Lords of the Night,” but the hieroglyphic names of the nine-day god names are still unclear.



Numerology applied

Numerology is about the meaning of the numbers in our lives. There are different systems that is different from each other. For example, in a number of systems the century has been included in the addition of the number of birth dates and in others not. I keep a system myself where this does differ. Within the numerology we know, among other things, the year number, the birth number and the karma number.

Moreover, the numerology can be used for everyday things in life, such as determining a favorable day to go on holiday, comparing two people within a partnership, house numbers and much more. Numerology is very fascinating. The method I use myself is linked to astrology and the aspects of the planets. It has no meaning to predict only, but to understand yourself better so you will know who you are.

When determining the numerological aspects of a person, we use the date of birth without the century. Here is the day before the performance to the outside world; the month for thinking; and the year for feeling. From these numbers the karma number can be calculated, the fate in this life.

An example of a system that works with the current 26-letter alphabet is the system of Gijsbert van der Zeeuw. He works with the numbers 1 to 9 and with the master numbers 11, 22, 33 and 44. You do not count the latter as the end number. The 0 also has a special meaning. At the number 30, for example, the 0 amplifies the previous number. You count the other numbers of two or more digits together until they have been reduced to a number. Example: 21-12-2012 = 2 + 1 + 1 + 2 + 2 + 0 + 1 + 2 = 11 the masternumber. And 1 + 1 = 2.

Numerological 26-letter alphabet

The letters in this method are numbered in exactly the same order as they are numbered in the alphabet. The A stands for the 1, the B for the 2 and so on. That way you can not only calculate dates, house numbers and the like, but also names that can say something about people, animals or places. Example: Arjen = 1a + 18r + 10j + 5e +14n = 48 = 12 = 3

Numerology is as old as humanity itself, there is no culture from antiquity without numbers mysticism. The founder of contemporary Western numerology is Pythagoras (569-470 BC), who told us that each number has its own vibration and with it its own special characteristics. He also said that everything can be expressed numerically, because everything can ultimately be reduced to numbers. He acquired this knowledge from the Jewish Kabbalah. Tangible examples of the knowledge one had in ancient times about the symbolism of numbers include pyramids. The dimensions and shape of, for example, the pyramid of Giza, is so measured that it contains positive and healing energy. Even with today’s computer technology, it is almost impossible to calculate and build this pyramid, whose slanting sides are at a special and arithmetically complicated angle on earth. Also the proportions of the dimensions that are related to the time count and the lookout shafts that look exactly at a number of constellations, show that the builders of this pyramid were not only mathematical arithmetic wonders, but that they also took the special properties of numbers into account and saw numbers as sources of power and energy.

Less certain but remarkable are the pieces by the composer Bach, who also seemed to have knowledge of the symbolism of numbers. Over the years, various studies have been conducted into his compositions in which the number 14, for example, can be discovered remarkably often. According to the alphabet code B = 2, A = 1, C = 3 and H = 8, researchers and scientists have uncovered 14 entire compositions by means of a simple addition with that number. As if they were measuring pyramids, which were also built according to certain distance ratios.

Various methods

Numerologists can be subdivided according to the method they use. In all methods numbers are linked to letters (A = 1, B = 2 etc.) The two main methods currently in use are: the ‘Hebrew System’ (in which the Hebrew alphabet is the basis and there is a relation with the Tarot and the Kabbalah), and the ‘Pythagorean System’ (in which the Latin alphabet serves as a starting point). Sometimes numerologists use a third system: the Phonetic System. Other numerologists have modern variants, based solely on the Latin alphabet or the modern alphabet.

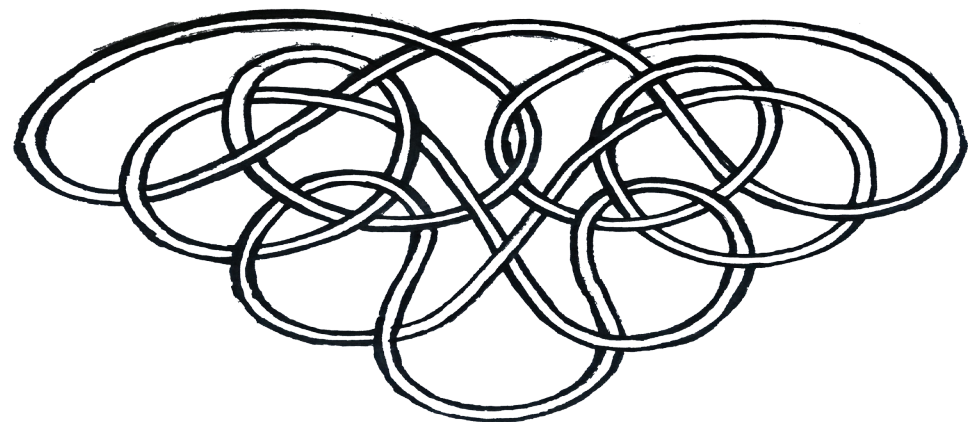

The Hebrew key is mainly used in connection with the kabalistic interpretation of the Holy Scriptures, as in the Zohar. Numerologists consider this method particularly suitable for the tarot interpretation by means of the Twenty-Two Mayor Arcana.

The Hebrew method also has three sub-secrets: the Temurah, the Gematria and the Notaricon.

The Pythagorean alphabet also works with dozens, hundreds and thousands. The phonetic alphabet is mainly used in connection with the planetary meanings from astrology. The first modern variant is based on the Latin alphabet in which I and J are the same letter, just like the U and V. The second modern variant is based on the modern 26-letter alphabet.

Special numbers

The symbolic meaning of a number can give rise to special interpretations of something that is expressed by a number or a combination of numbers, such as a date or year. Some of these interpretations, however, are not consistent with the ‘classical’ conception of numerology. For example, from the beginning of the year 2000 all sorts of calamity was expected, just because it is a nice round number. Sometimes a number gets a new meaning as a result of deliberate actions: an example of this is the number 911, the telephone number of the emergency center in the United States, which played a role in a number of terrorist attacks.

Numbers are also sometimes used as a name for a phenomenon (020 = Amsterdam, agent 007 = James Bond). This language is not part of the numerology. In addition to the meaning given to the numbers themselves, numbers in a specific cultural-historical context can therefore refer to an understanding, without a numerological background being present. An example of alleged numerical symbolism, which can be found on Wikipedia, is the terrorist attacks on 11 September 2001, a date written on his American as 9-11. The number 911 is the number of the alarm center in the United States. In the Netherlands exactly 911 days after the murder of Pim Fortuyn (6 May 2002) Theo van Gogh was killed. The date of that murder shows 11-2 in his American way of notation and 112 is the European emergency number.

These facts could well be based on coincidence and it has not been shown that the perpetrators of the attacks would have chosen the dates because of their symbolic value.

About the value attributed to number symbolism has long been a lot to do, especially when it comes to the assertions, for example, that in scriptures such as the Bible and other holy books, or in music of Bach numbers, there would be a hidden coding. Arguments against the use of numbers as symbols include that the human pattern recognition often makes incorrect assumptions and often randomly delineates its research area, in other words random pattern data. Thus (as an example) in the number 14 you can both code the name Bach ($B = 2 + A = 1 + C = 3 + H = 8$) and for example the word ‘clue’ ($C = 3 + L = 3 + U = 3 + E = 5$). Numerology is therefore a lot under attack.

Key number

Modern numerologists claim to be able to apply their occult ‘knowledge’ of number symbolism to the analysis of character, future predictions, problem solving and countless other issues. The numerologist then codes according to a certain system of encrypting the alphabet (see above) a word or name or date, and reduces this to a ‘key number’ by adding the letter values together. Other codings are also possible, such as through magic squares. Subsequently, this ‘key number’ is reduced to a number between 0 and 9 (there are also other systems), by adding together all numbers that are above 9.

Again a small example: when the word “bach” is seen ($B = 2, A = 1, C = 3, H = 8$) the sum is the “key number” 14, and then the 1 is added to the 4 again so that the result is the ‘key number’. The so-called name of “bach” thus becomes 5.

Furthermore, every number between 0 and 9 would have a symbolic meaning, and so the number 5 could then be brought in connection with a hidden (occult) quality of ‘bach’.

The same principle also applies numerologists to data: for example “17 May 1961” becomes with keynumber = 13:
 $17 + 13 + 5 + 1961 = 1996 = 1 + 9 + 9 + 6 = 7$. Also “17-05-1961” can be viewed if $17 + 5 + 1961 = 1983 = 1 + 9 + 8 + 3 = 21 = 2 + 1 = 3$. In this case it already appears that the outcome is every time different. Numerologists explain this for example, because the initial spelling determines the type of information that would have been coded.

This last example already shows that many interpretations of numbers are possible, which is therefore the most important argument of those who count numerology as pseudosciences.

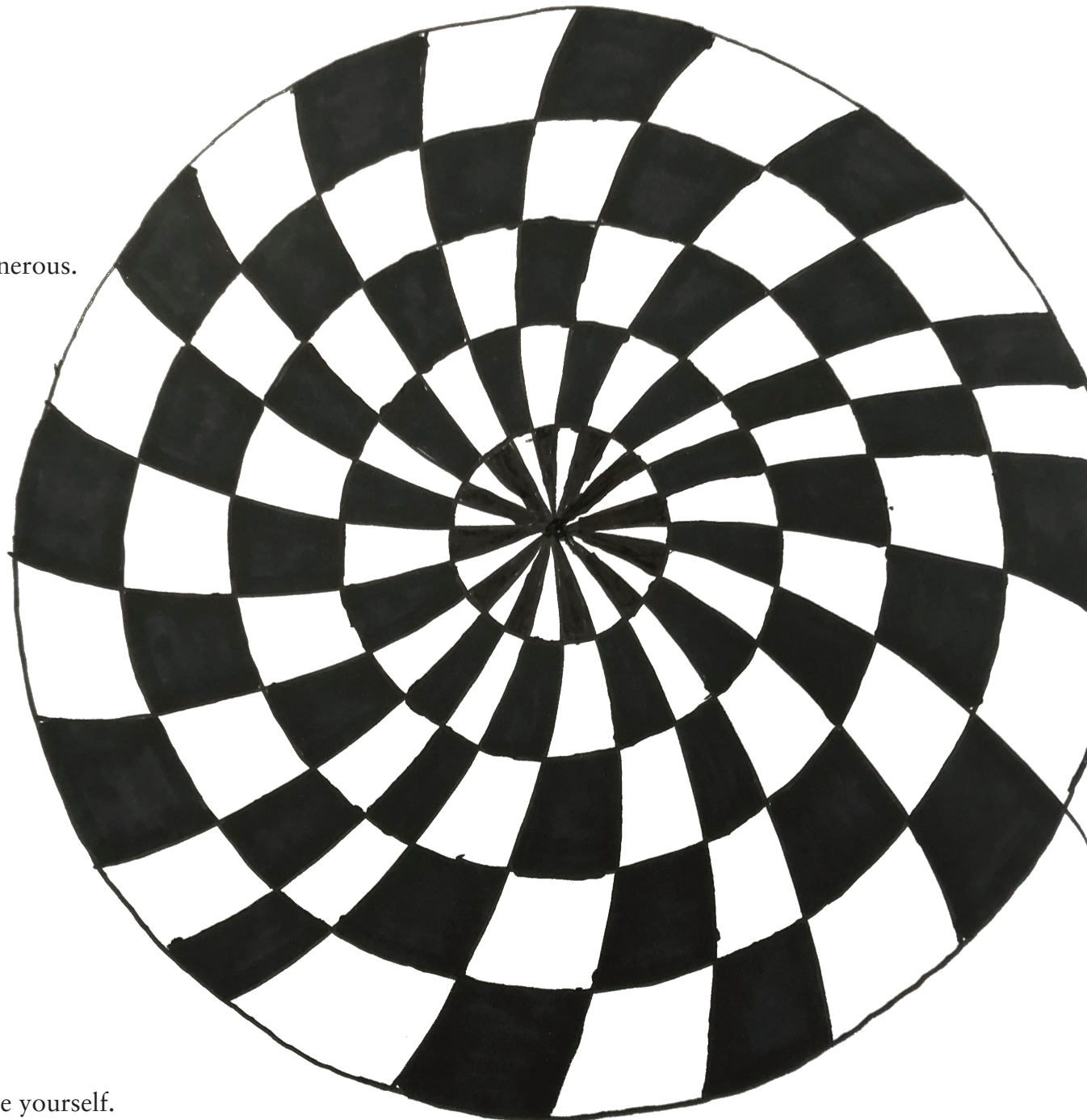

The year number shows you in which year of the cycle you are. The annual number applies from the day of your last birthday to your upcoming birthday.

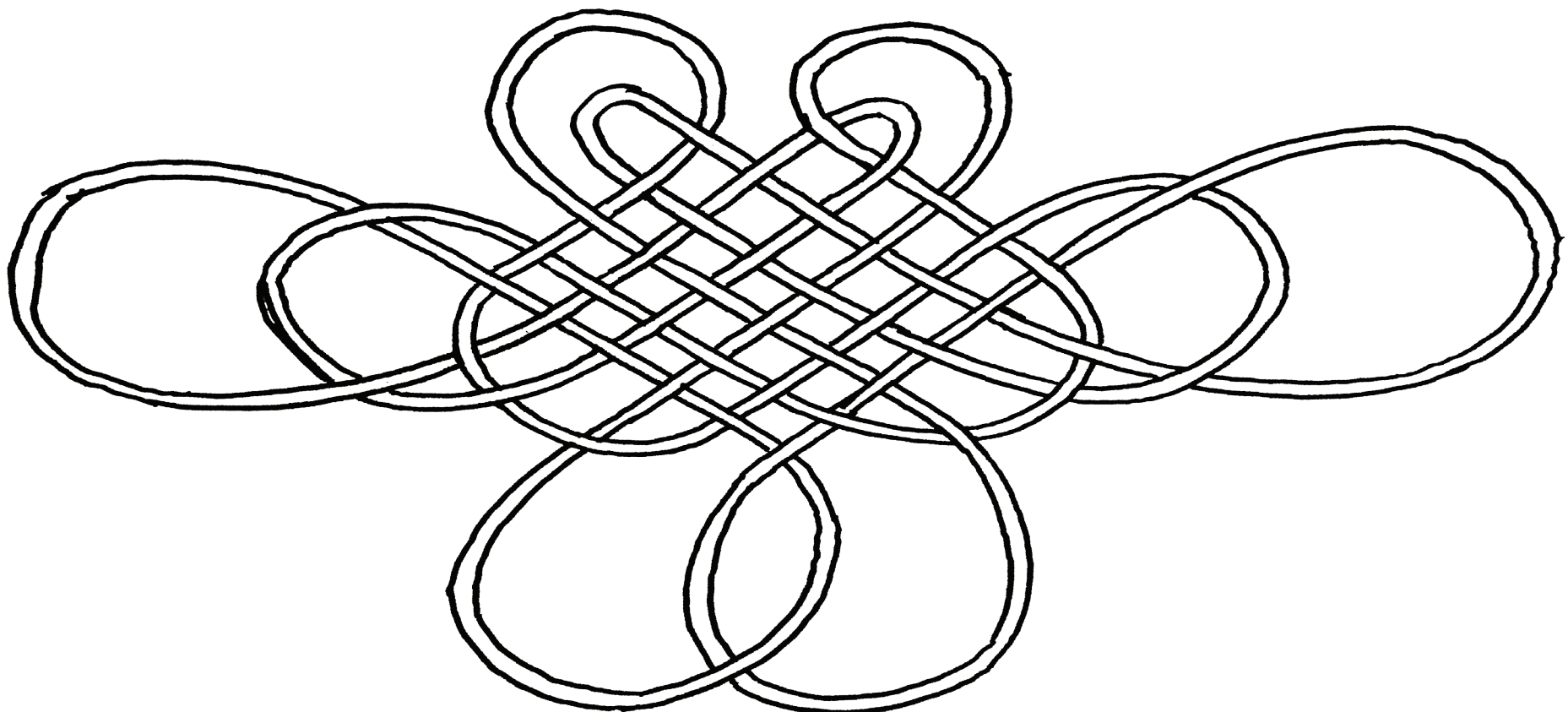
Life course analysis

And there are seven Takbieraat of al-'Ied in the first prayer unit. The Prophet (peace be upon him) also said: "Encourage your children to pray at their seventh." (Abu Daawood and Ahmad) If a boy reaches the age of seven, he should according to a tradition choose between his (divorced) parents. According to another tradition, his father is more entitled to him than his mother. And according to a third tradition, his mother is more entitled to him. When the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) was ill, he commanded water to be poured over him from seven skins. Allah sent the wind seven days to the people of cAad. The Prophet (peace be on him) asked Allah to help him by sending his people seven (years), like the seven years of Yusuf (peace be upon him), namely seven years of scarcity. Allah has compared the reward of the one who gives charity to grain that produces seven spikes, in which there is in every one hundred grains. The number of corn that was seen (in a dream) by the companion of Yusuf (peace be upon him) was seven. The number of years that these ears were cultivated is seven and (the reward) multiplied by seven hundred times or more. Seventy thousand of this community will enter Paradise without justification. Ibn ul-Qayyim then explains: "Without a doubt, this number has a number of unique properties that other numbers do not have. Allah knows His Wisdom, Laws and Prejudice best in specifying and excepting this number". Based on this is the correct opinion to refrain from discussing the reason why this number is excluded, except on the basis of clear and authentic evidence.

Positive aspects

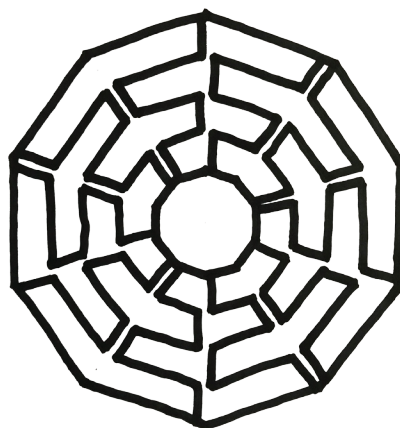

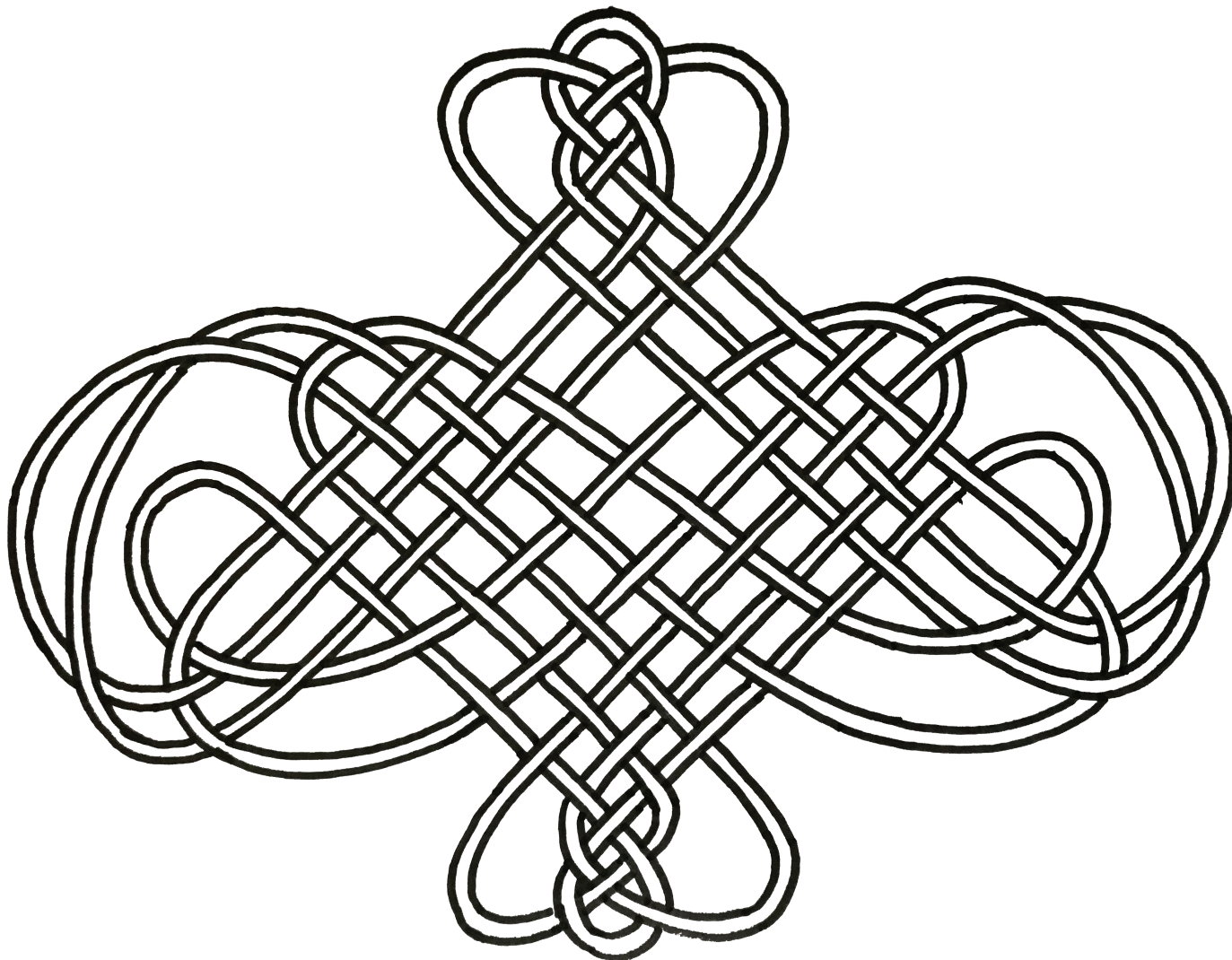

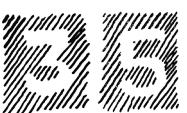
